Fill Up Procedure

1. Remove any debris from your hot tub.
2. Remove the filter shield/weir to expose the filter and remove the filter cartridge by turning it counterclockwise.
3. Insert your garden hose into the empty filter fitting. **Always** fill your hot tub using this method. See above photo.
4. Fill the tub to the bottom of the head rests/ above the highest jets. (With the exception of the neck jets on the S620 model).
5. Once the spa is filled put the filter back in and attach the filter weir.
6. Turn on the power by the GFCI. The heater and pump will automatically activate.

Winter start-up and use

- **Start up:** when starting up your hot tub in the winter, please warm up the inside of your hot tub prior to filling it with a ceramic space heater
- **Servicing:** If for some reason your hot tub stops heating or circulating in the winter, please install a ceramic space heater promptly in order to protect your hot tub.

Winter start-up and use

Your hot tub **must be operating** or professionally winterized from November 1st to April 1st to prevent the risk of freeze damage.

Freeze damage is NOT covered under the manufacturer's warranty

Electrical Hook up

Your hot tub must be wired by a certified electrician. Please ensure they follow the wiring diagram that is in the hot tub.

Always refer to the diagram in your hot tub. Diagrams included in instructional materials are for illustration purposes only.

*Improper hook up will result in error messages on start up and may damage the hot tub.

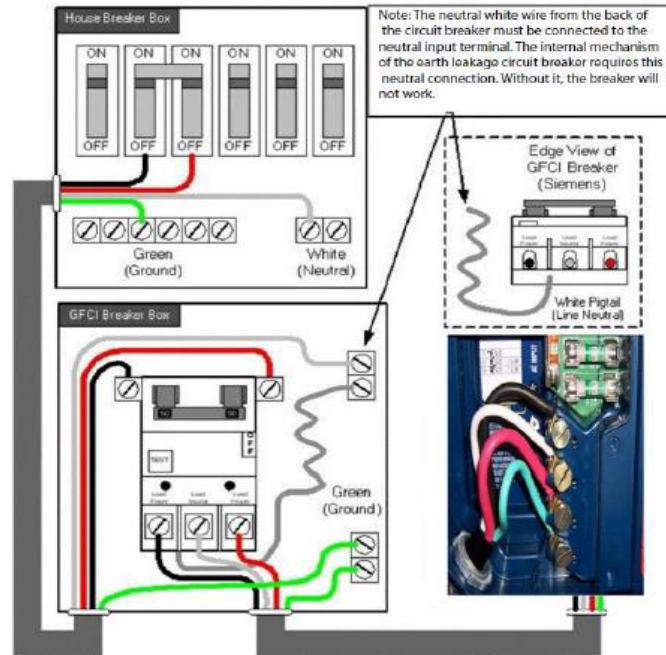


Figure 3 - Cable schematics

IMPORTANT: To allow the GFCI to function properly, connect the white Neutral the spa / hot tub to the Neutral terminal on the GFCI breaker, not the Neutral in the GFCI breaker box. An improperly connected Neutral causes the GFCI to trip.

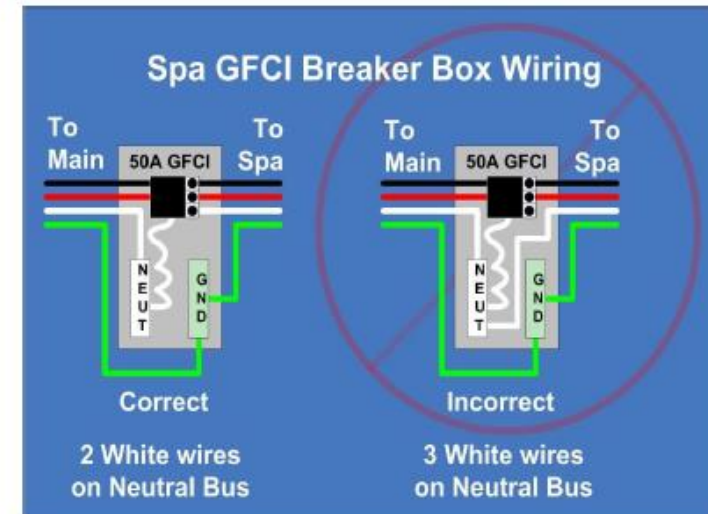


Figure 2 - GFCI Wiring

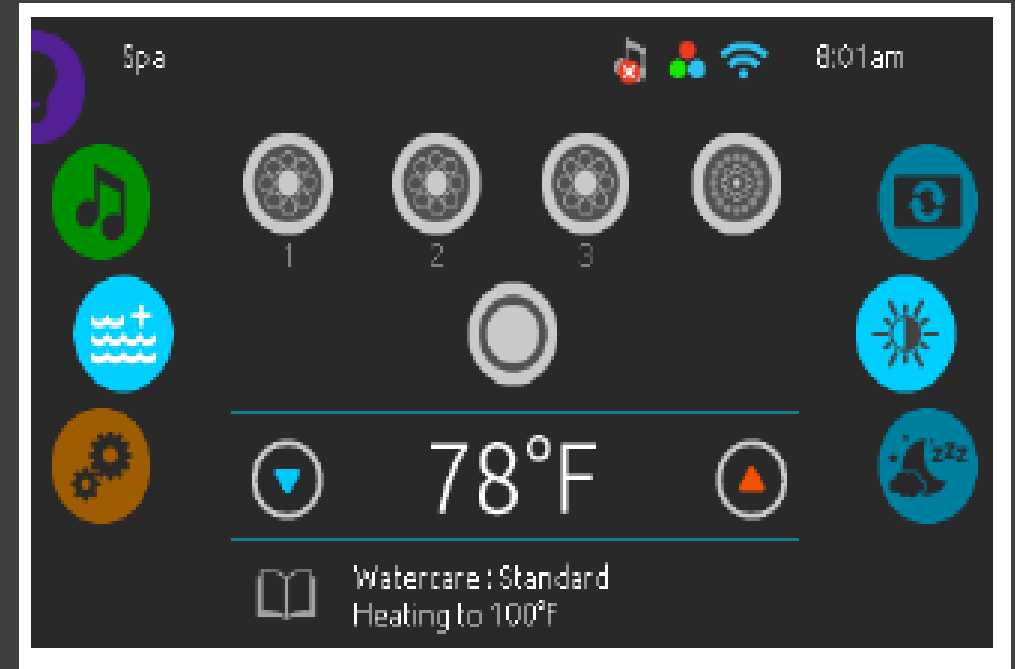
Navigating Your Topside Panel

Home Screen

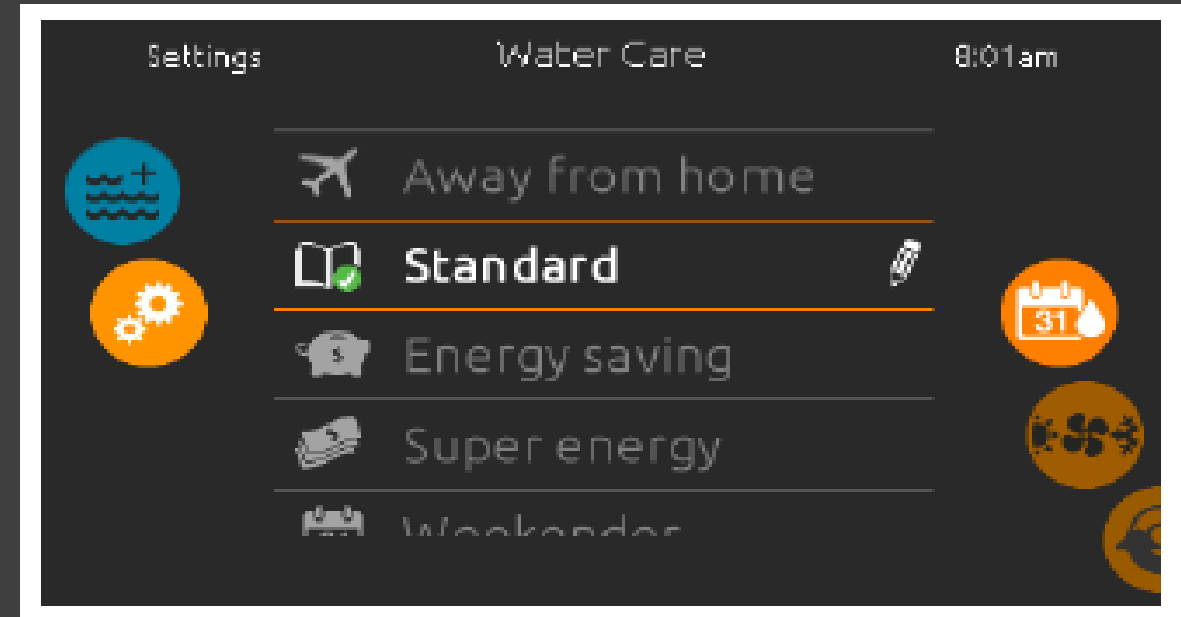
- The main screen displays the water temperature and provides access to hot tub's features and accessories.
- It will display any error or maintenance messages that are present.
- To start or stop an accessory, touch the associated icon. Icons will become animated when their accessory is turned on and the animation will stop when turned off. Icons on the screen will reflect the speed or state of the devices running on your spa. When an accessory has more than one speed press the button until it reaches the desired speed (low, high, or off).
- Use the red Up and blue Down icons to set the desired temperature. The set temperature will appear in blue. After 3 seconds without any change to the set temperature value the current water temperature will reappear in white.



Water Care

- The Water Care page will help you set up your ideal filtration and heating settings.
- Here you can choose between *Away from Home*, **Standard**, *Energy Savings*, *Super Energy*, and *Weekender*.
- Touch the Water Care name to choose your setting.
- A green check mark will appear on the selected icon to confirm your choice.

***** In Canada, your hot tub should always be in STANDARD *****





Water Care Modes

Note: Your hot tub should ALWAYS be set to Standard mode.

Away:

In this mode the spa will always be in economy; the set point will be reduced by 20° F.

Standard:

The spa will never be in economy mode and will be filtering according to the pack's low-level configuration.

Energy Savings:

The spa will be in economy mode during the peak hours of the day and resume normal mode on the weekend.

Super Energy Savings:

The spa will always be in economy mode during peak hours, every day of the week.

Weekender:

The spa will be in economy mode from Monday to Friday and will run normally on the weekend.

Important Notes when using your hot tub



- Always unclip all clips front and back before opening your cover
- When adding chemicals always leave the cover off for 20 minutes to protect the life of your cover.
- Leave the cover ON when heating.
- Always remove snow and ice prior to opening the cover.
- Have your water tested monthly professionally. Free testing is available at your local Club Piscine.

Diverter and Air Controls – How they work

CONTROL ACCESSORIES

- **Air venturi**

- These settings jets will allow you to control the flow of water or air delivered by your nozzles.
- The toning massages provided by the venturi jets allow a fast and lasting relaxation of the muscles

- **Diverter valve**

Spas are equipped with a 3-way valve that can control 1 seat up to 7 seats. The three (3) valve lets you share your jets in each seat. Reversing the flow of water is possible at the deviation chute installed in your spa.

- **Waterfall control**

The controller has an ON and OFF position. When you turn the joystick to ON, the waterfall will start working.

- **Vulcano Jet control**

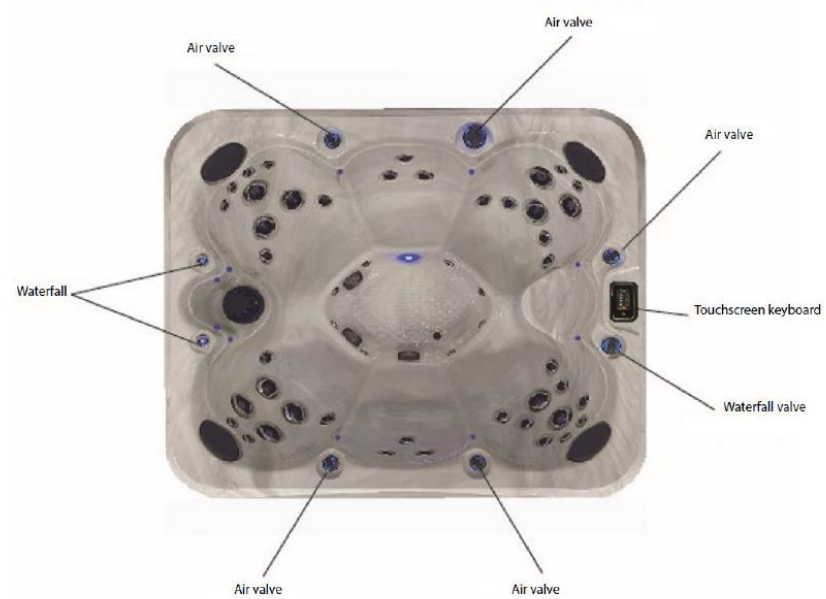
Spas equipped with a Vulcano jet is controlled by the 3-way valves. The diverter valve allows to activate or not the Vulcano jet.

Hot tub configuration

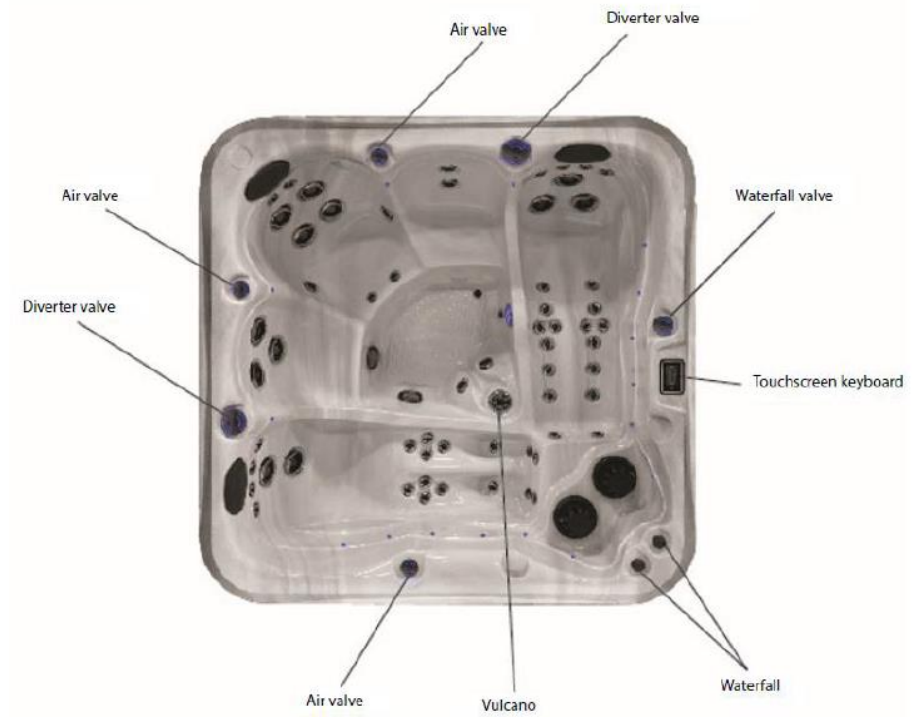

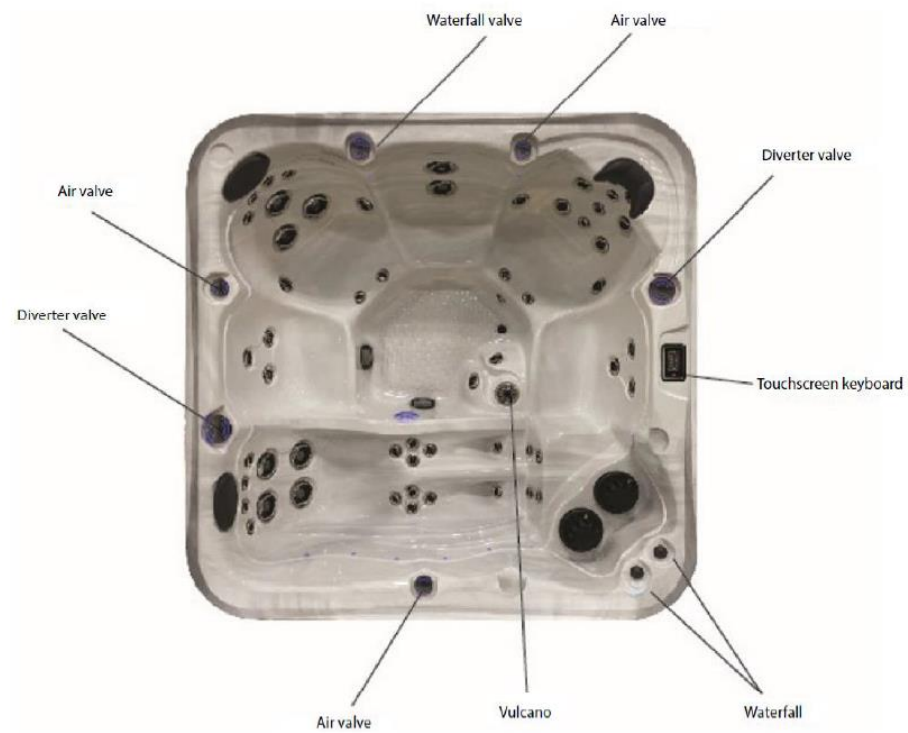
